alicia is always a surprising destination. This region of north-western Spain is a sharp contrast to the image typically held abroad of the Spanish landscape. A beautiful example of this is the "Playa de las Catedrales" (The Cathedrals' Beach) where you can walk into the caves when there's low tide. Galicia belongs to the **Green Spain**, with the singularity that the Rías Baixas (the low estuaries) are the sunniest part of the northern Spanish coast. With an average temperature of 18° degrees, it has the perfect weather to enjoy our amazing natural treasures, like the Cíes Islands, where we find the Rodas Beach that with its crystal waters and white sand is considered the best beach of the world.

Every culture and people have a former civilisation that usually has influenced the new inhabitants and their traditions. In Galicia the most numerous and spectacular remains left by previous occupants of this land are normally **Roman, Jewish** or from the Middle Ages, but the most important ones kept here are **Celtic**. They have not only left gems like the forts of Santa Tecla and Castro Baroña, but an invisible trace in the almost 3 million inhabitants character, which is warm and welcoming to the visitor.

The capital is **Santiago de Compostela**, a **UNESCO World Heritage** city that oozes history. St. James the Apostle is buried in its incredible cathedral that marks the end of the way to Santiago, **the Pilgrim's Way** that has been travelled by millions of people from all over the world for centuries.

Galicia has an enormous richness in the belowground waters with medicinal properties, what has favoured the construction of fabulous health resorts situated in spots of immense natural beauty. **Galician Spas** have very modern facilities with highly specialised staff, what makes them a reference when it comes to health tourism.

Eating in Galicia is not a necessity but an art. The Galician **gastronomy** is one of the best in Spain, and the variety is its signature. It is characterized by using healthy and natural ingredients and by the simplicity and abundance of its dishes. Our main reference is seafood and the variety of fish. This combined with the carefully selected **Galician wines** are just the perfect match.

The evolution of golf practise in Galicia has meant an important increase in the number of courses where to play this sport. Mondariz

A Coruña - 195 Km Santiago - 120 Km Oporto - 157 Km Vigo - 35 Km

The **archaeological remains** prove that this territory has been occupied since **prehistory**, as well as in Roman times. The Roman settlement was bigger, and evidences of this are the different Roman constructions found in the village, like the Roman road by the river Tea, or the Cernadela Bridge.

Mondariz is considered nowadays one of **the best health resorts in Spain**. It is a reference of thermalism in Galicia and among the best establishments of the same kind in Europe, due to the **medicinal properties** of the water and the quality of the services offered.

The Golf course Balneario Mondariz was **designed by Álvaro Arana**. It has 18 holes par 71 in a beautiful valley where you can relax and enjoy yourself.

Ribeira Sacra

The artistic and monumental richness of the Ribeira Sacra merges with the unbelievable natural surroundings, where silence seems music from nature.

There are a great variety of amazing natural landscapes, with perfect conditions for the practise of outdoor activities. In the rivers Miño and Sil we can take a **cruise in a catamaran** to discover the incredible landscapes of the **Ribeira Sacra**, or go hiking while we admire its characteristic vineyards on the hills. This area also has fountains of **sulphurous medicinal water** that is used in the Augas Santas Spa and the Recenderes fountain.

The Augas Santas golf course is 50 meters away from the Augas Santas Spa Hotel 4* and very close to the Parador de Santo Estevo Hotel 4*. It comprises an area of 50 hectares and stands out for being almost flat and for its well protected greens. It has three huge lakes and a small river that goes through the green and borders some of the holes.

It was **designed by Alfonso Vidaor.** The 5.344 meters of the course are divided in 18 holes, of which three are par 5, ten par 4 and five par 3, summing up a total of par 70.

Accommodation

The Augas Santas Hotel 4* is located next to the ruins of the old "Fontes de Augas Santas" Spa, which was very popular for the aristocracy and the upper classes at the beginning of the 19th century, and was forgotten after the mid 1950's. Since its opening in 2006 the Augas Santas Hotel represents a modern and complete offer for the thermal tourism. It has 105 very comfortable and fully equipped rooms that will make the delight of every guest after a relaxing spa session.

Another beautiful option of accommodation in this area is the Parador de Santo Estevo Hotel 4*. This former Benedictine monastery from the 7th century is located in the heart of the Ribeira Sacra and was declared Historic Artistic Monument in the 1923. The Hotel has a total of 77 rooms distributed around three cloisters of different styles and periods. The rooms are particularly interesting as they are all different, some with impressive views over the landscape and the valley of the river Sil.





Vigo
